1. Which words in Genesis 6 describe the moral decline of humanity?
2. "Noah found grace in the eyes of the Lord" (Gen 6:4). In what ways did God demonstrate His grace toward Noah?
3. What challenges could have caused Noah's faith to waiver?
4. Notice the references to God's commands in Genesis 6:22; 7:5, 9, 16. What is the relationship between faith and obedience?
5. How did grace, faith, and works result in saving Noah's family in the flood?
6. What are some similarities between Noah's salvation in the ark and our salvation in Christ?
7. Are there differences in how faith and works saved Noah in the flood and how our faith and works affect our salvation?
