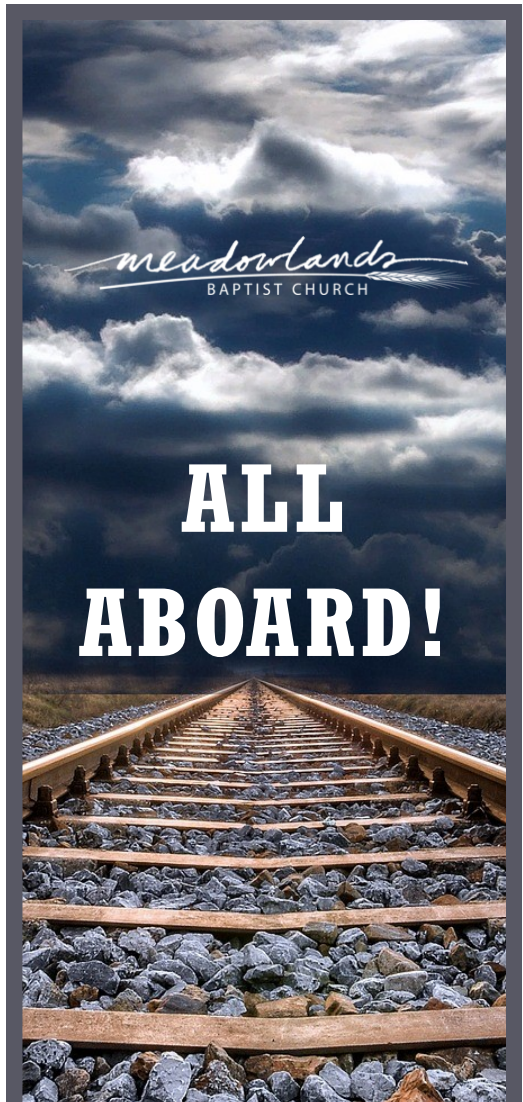


BIBLE STUDY PRINCIPLES

BOOK OF HEBREWS


BRYAN STATT | 11:00 | ROOM 207

BOOK OF COLOSSIANS

The church at Colossae was under attack from false teachers who were denigrating the deity of Jesus; like today, these false teachers were teaching that He was not actually God. Though Paul had never been to this church, he addressed these issues head-on. The nature of Jesus Christ as God was nonnegotiable. Our study will focus on Christ's preeminence and sufficiency in all things. Christ was, and is, the visible image of the invisible God, containing within Himself the fullness of Deity!

BIBLICAL WORLDVIEW
