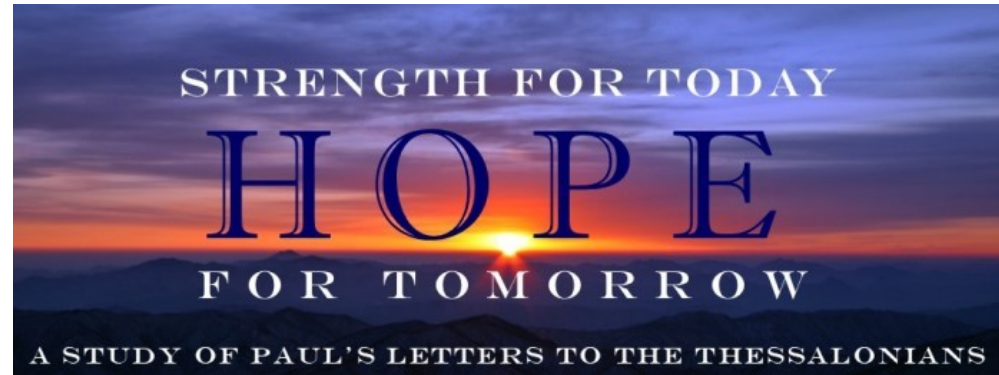

3. Paul told these believers that he was praying for them. Have you been encouraged by someone telling you about their prayers for you? How can you encourage others in this way?
4. Using Paul's prayer as a model, for what should you pray for your fellow believers? (1 Thes 3:9-13)
5. What is Paul's ultimate goal for these Christians? (1 Thes 3:13)
6. Are Paul's prayer concerns different from what you usually pray about? In what ways?
7. Is there anything about your prayer life that you want to change after studying 1 Thessalonians 3:9-13?
