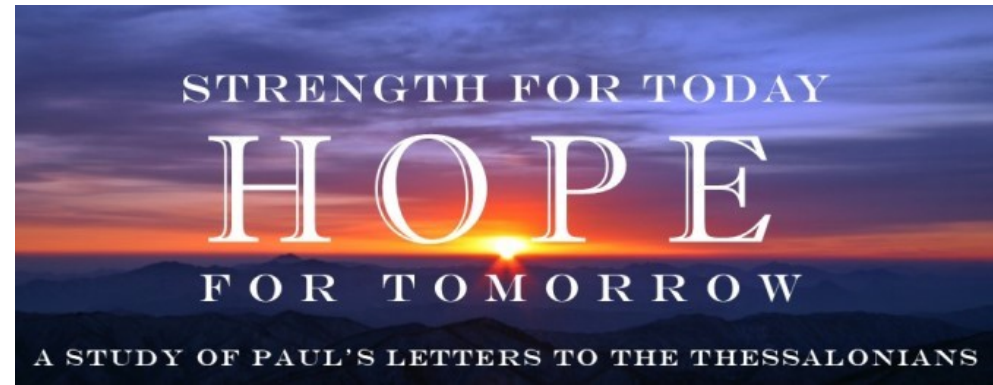

## BIBLE STUDY QUESTIONS (WEDNESDAYS AT 7 PM)
