## BIBLE STUDY QUESTIONS (WEDNESDAYS AT 7 PM)

- 1. What was the problem in the Thessalonian church? (2 Thes 3:6-12)
- 2. What instruction does Paul give to these disorderly people? (2 Thes 3:7-12)
- 3. List all the commands that Paul gives to the church in 2 Thessalonians 3:6-15.
- 4. Paul encourages the Christians not to grow weary in doing good (2 Thes 3:13). How can the disobedience of other believers discourage your walk with God?
- 5. We are commanded to "withdraw from" (2 Thes 3:6) and "not keep company with" (2 Thes 3:14). What situations would require us to take such drastic measures toward a fellow believer?
- 6. Paul states that the goal of this separation is to bring shame (2 Thes 3:14). What is the ultimate goal of this shame?
- 7. This required social separation doesn't completely eliminate all communication. According to 2 Thessalonians 3:15, how should we communicate with an unrepentant believer?
