Dear Church Family,

By now you have probably heard that Premier Kenney has declared a public health state of emergency for our province. Many new restrictions have been enacted that affect social gatherings, businesses, schools, and places of worship.

Here are the mandates that specifically affect our church gatherings. Physical distance (2 metres) between households should be maintained at all times. Face masks are required by the provincial government for everyone inside the building. Face coverings are certainly uncomfortable and even a source of controversy, but we can submit to our authorities for Christ's sake (Matt 22:21; 1 Pet 2:13-17). I'm glad that online services are available to those who are unable to wear a mask or are uneasy with these guidelines.

There is also a strict limit of one-third capacity for the space that we meet in. We have maintained this ratio in the auditorium and gym, so there is no need to alter our current practice. Our children's Sunday school and adult fellowship groups, however, have often exceeded this limit, so we are going to suspend these gatherings for the next few weeks. This means that we will continue to have our regular services on Sundays (9:30 a.m., 11:00 a.m., 6:00 p.m.) but will not have any classes or small groups. Our current attendance numbers on Wednesdays will allow us to continue Kids 4 Truth and Prayer/Bible study.

We are grateful that the Lord has provided a large building in which we can spread out. We also rejoice that these new restrictions do not hinder us from worshipping together on Sundays. We urge you to pray for the governing leaders God has appointed over us (Rom 13:1-7; 1 Tim 2:1-2). They bear a great responsibility to keep the citizens of Alberta safe.

The last several months have been difficult for many in our church family. Let's be sensitive to the needs of those around us and encourage others with God's truth. Our mission doesn't stop during a pandemic. May we rely on the Lord's grace as we seek to love God, serve others, and reach the world for His glory.
