He desired to see spiritual maturity in their lives.

They drive their kids all over town for practices, games, recitals, and a myriad of other activities. But what is the purpose in all this? Are there any specified goals to be accomplished? Paul lays out four goals for the believers he loved. Setting some goals is a good place to begin. First, Paul prays that their "love may abound more and more" (v. 9). Paul wanted to see each Christian love God with all his heart. He also wanted to see them love their neighbors. Second, he wanted them to "approve the things that are excellent" (v. 10). They needed spiritual discernment. Paul wanted them to test all things and only make choices that were best. He did not want them to settle for mediocrity. Third, Paul desired that they have genuine character—"sincere and without offence" (v. 10). He wanted them to be real, not just putting on an outward show of godliness. Paul's fourth goal was fruitfulness (v. 11). He wanted to see outward evidence of an inward faith.

As a Christian father, how are you praying for your children? What spiritual goals would you like to see accomplished in their lives? How are you planning to help them grow in godly maturity? If you lack clear goals, success is not likely. Start with Paul's prayer in Philippians 1. Pray it. Model it. And establish priorities in your family to see these goals accomplished "for the glory and praise of God" (v. 11).
