

As we approach September, many ministries are being planned for this fall. Kids 4 Truth registrations are already underway for children ages four to grade six to begin classes on Wednesday, September 8. In addition to this, we are adding a nursery (infant to age three) and teen classes to coincide with a new parenting class called *Intentional Parenting* beginning Wednesday, September 15.

As fall scheduling returns on Sunday, September 12, I want to encourage parents to attend the 9:30 morning service as a family and then stay on for the 11:00 time to connect with the Adult Bible Study Fellowship Groups and Children's Sunday School Ministries that will be offered to everyone. Yes, the morning will be extended for younger kids, and this may present its challenges. However, the benefits far exceed a missed nap. Families need to be together as the Body of Christ. If we separate children from the main service, they do not learn to be a part of the body, with all ages and stages of life together. Attending church together is an integral part of discipling our children. They have opportunity to see their parents singing, worshipping, listening to and responding to the sermon as well as observing the Lord's Supper. All this can result in questions which can result in teaching moments afterwards. What is another benefit of attending one service together as a family in addition to Sunday School? Our children learn they are part of something bigger. They are part of the family of God. They observe other family units from all cultures and backgrounds making up a new family, the family of God, because of what Christ has accomplished on the cross for us.

How can you help your children to be engaged in the main service? Provide a special notebook and writing utensil just for church. Encourage them to follow along and depending on their age, draw a picture of something they hear from the sermon (younger children), or write down some words or sentences from what they hear. Assist them in looking up Bible passages. Discuss what they learned over lunch. I highly implore you not to miss out on this means of discipling your children.
