

With responsibility comes authority. The janitor needs keys to the rooms he is responsible to clean. And with that authority comes accountability. The keys must be used for the purpose for which they were given. The church also has responsibility, authority, and accountability.

Since Christ is the head of the church (Eph 5:23; Col 1:18), He is the ultimate authority, and all other authority is delegated from Him. He has given the congregation

various responsibilities, and they are also given the authority to carry out their obligations. Some of those responsibilities include affirming new members (Matt 16:18–19), removing unrepentant members (Matt 18:17– 18; 1 Cor 5:4-5; 2 Cor 2:6), selecting leaders (Acts 6:2-6), and rejecting false teaching (Gal 1:6-8). With this authority, the congregation is accountable to Christ for the way that authority is used. Christ has also appointed pastors as authorities in His church. They have the responsibility of teaching God's Word (1 Tim 3:2; Tit 1:9), taking care of the church (1 Tim 3:5), leading God's sheep (Acts 20:28), and providing spiritual protection (1 Pet 5:2). Along with these responsibilities God has given them authority. The congregation is commanded to obey them and be submissive (1 Thess 5:12-13; Heb 13:17). And with this authority comes accountability from the Chief Shepherd (Heb 13:17; 1 Pet 5:4).

To summarize, the congregation is responsible for **what** the church believes and **who** affirms and teaches it. The church members are accountable to God and must not delegate these responsibilities to some other governing body. The pastors are responsible for **how** the church carries out its mission. They equip the saints for ministry (Eph 4:11-12) and lead them to obey by word and example (1 Pet 5:2-3). Christ is honored when His people and their shepherds work together to fulfill their responsibilities for His glory.


