

Church Membership

Some stores give discounts or rewards to their members. Others require membership just to enter. Membership may have costs and benefits. But church membership is something quite different. The idea of "member" comes from two main pictures of the church given in the New Testament—members of a body (Rom 12:5) and members of a family (Eph 2:19). The local church is a gathering of real believers in a real place with a purpose and responsibilities.

In a previous article, I listed some of the duties God has given to each member of a local church. You have the

responsibility to affirm the profession of believers (Matt 16:18-19), remove unrepentant members (Matt 18:17-18; 1 Cor 5:4-5), select leaders (Acts 6:2-6), and reject false doctrine (Gal 1:6-8). These are weighty responsibilities, and not everyone who occupies a seat on Sunday is allowed to decide such critical issues. A meaningful church membership ensures that only true believers committed to a particular body and family are to make these decisions. These duties are the obligation of every Christian. If you are not involved in these decisions as a formal member of a local church, then I encourage you to take the next step. A detailed membership process is not spelled out in the New Testament Scriptures, but it's clear that believers in those early assemblies knew who belonged and who didn't.

I rejoice in the communities of believers that God has used in my life over the years. None of them were perfect, partly because I was a member, but each one was a New Testament church that took the responsibilities of God's Word seriously. The Meadowlands family has been a gracious gift from the Lord to me. I pray that He will use us together for His glory as we seek to be faithful in the responsibilities He has given.

This activity takes place at Meadowlands. Bring your favourite Nerf blaster and even extra if you have them (Please label.). Darts will be provided.




