It reminds us of Solomon's proverb: "The king's heart is in the hand of the Lord, as a stream of water, He turns it wherever He will" (Prov 21:1).

As we read the headlines coming from Ukraine, we grieve over the senseless taking of life. We shed tears as we watch hundreds of thousands of our fellow human beings flee their homes in hope of safety. We may even wonder how something like this could happen in Europe in the 21st Century. Just as we anticipate getting our lives back to normal, the world dramatically changed a week ago.


But God is still on His throne! He is the King of kings and the Lord of lords. He is sovereign over all, and no earthly power rivals His omnipotence. Vladimir Putin is a hard-hearted dictator, but his heart is in the Lord's hand. And the leaders of Ukraine and NATO nations are also under God's control. That is why we do more than grieve…we pray. We pray for God to intervene to end this conflict. We pray for peace in Ukraine. We pray for their protection and provision.

And we especially pray for our brothers and sisters in Christ. For several years now, the Meadowlands church family has partnered with Baptist International Evangelistic Ministries that supplies theological training and humanitarian aid to 120 churches throughout Ukraine called "The Brotherhood of Independent Baptist Churches." Their president, Sam Slobodian, visited us in 2019, and he is asking us to pray for the believers in their churches. You can read testimonies and watch recent videos of pastors on their website.

You can also give funds that will go directly to these churches to help them as they minister humanitarian aid and Gospel hope.
