MISSIONARY UPDATE



THE BURRILLS IN MALTA

Along with the Mifsud family and the Tanis family, we continue to lead our people through our Sunday fellowships, mid-week fellowships both in Malta and Gozo, Thursday ladies' Bible studies, and twice-monthly young adult Bible studies. It has been encouraging to have two of the young men in our church assist in the leadership of our young adult ministry and teen ministry. In between these set ministry times, we try to fit in as many other meetings as we can.

One of the important growth steps our church must take is the development of lay leadership in the form of deacons and local pastors/elders. In the five years that we have been here, we have struggled to have qualified men that we could begin steering in this direction. We are grateful that we have seen growth in this area, and four men in the church have expressed interest in a mentorship/leadership internship program. We will have our first meeting together on the last Tuesday of this month and will discuss a book we are reading together along with talking more about our plans for the year. Pray that I will have wisdom as I lead the men through various aspects of Christian growth and servant-leadership. Pray for the growth of the men, and that their increased service will be a catalyst for further grown in the church. I am excited about this!

We rejoice at God's provision for our family and ministry! We have seen God meet personal support needs in ways that remind us that God cares for us as a loving Heavenly Father and knows exactly what our needs are. We have also seen exceedingly generous supply made for the building project. These gifts were given just at the time that we needed to pay substantial bills. Again, we have seen that God knows all these things and cares for His own, especially as they devote themselves to Christ's cause.
