THE ROYS TO SPAIN

Dear Supporters,

Meetings: So far, between our supporting churches and some new churches, we're scheduled to report to a church every Sunday through early June. The summer Sundays are mostly filled up too. We have been in a different church every week since February 27th.

Visas: I have started looking into the pre-visa application process, and have actually gotten some of the paperwork underway as I noticed a particular step prior to the visa application takes as much as 4 months due to lingering COVID delays. So the wheel has started to turn for the visa application. The process is quite involved, as it will require two trips to the DR for me to be able to obtain background checks (of where we have resided for the past 5 years) as part of the the visa application requirements. We can't apply for the visas until we have enough support to go to the field, but we're lining things up to be ready to apply when we can.

Dominican Republic: We have finally been able to get the legal papers back from the government that I need in order to transition out of the banking ties I have to the Bible college in the DR. Upon receiving those, they have been submitted to the bank. Now it is just a matter of seeing what the bank thinks we need to do. If all is well the internal bank process should only take a few weeks.

Two Classes: I have enjoyed my two classes that are coming to an end, the one I teach, and the module I'm taking. Hermeneutics, which I teach online at the SBI will be over before the end of the month, and so will the module that I am taking, Expository Preaching of OT and NT Prophecy.

Family: Our family is well. Olivia is making progress as she learns to read. Amy has enjoyed the process of teaching her. We're enjoying glimpses of warmer weather and more time in parks with the kids.

Transitions aren't easy, but we're grateful to the Lord for where He has us now, and we have seen His sovereign and providential hand through this. We're grateful we can be with our church during this transition time, and that we have the opportunity to reconnect with friends in supporting churches. We very much look forward to serving in Spain.
