Thank you all for your prayers for us. Pam has been dealing with after effects of Covid and also the side effects of a low red blood cell count. This past Friday they gave her a blood transfusion and it appears to be helping. She continues to handle the chemo treatments well, and the doctor will do another scan in late May to see how the cancer is responding to the treatments. Please continue to pray for Pam's healing.

Today we begin our trip to Aklavik. Things got changed due to Covid regulations and we had to reschedule this trip from last month. It will be a time of sadness as we will be packing up our belongings to bring back to the states later this year and start saying goodbye to the people we have ministered to for the last 16 years, but also a time of rejoicing as we anticipate what the Lord has next for us and for the Aklavik Baptist Church.

Please be in prayer for our time in Aklavik over the next 2 weeks as we visit and have services. We are planning a big Easter service to celebrate the resurrection of our Lord. Also please pray for the Lord to call a missionary or pastor to be in Aklavik full time. There is still a great work to be done!
