Dear Friends,

Thank you all so much for your unbelievable interest, giving, and prayer. I'm writing more often because I have more people writing me and asking for updates. As we wrote in our last update. Alexander took a load of humanitarian aid including items that are not available in Ukraine to western Ukraine to put on a semi. However, when he arrived, there was a semi-trailer loaded with food and essentials, but there was no driver. The previous driver was on the road for six days and needed a rest. Alexander then drove the semi himself to his hometown and to the distribution center at his church. He arrived Saturday afternoon and was able to spend a Sunday in his home church. On the way back to Poland he brought back 3 women and 4 children from his town. Since our house is at full capacity, we organized accommodations for them in a nearby hostel. Alexander's church has had some contact with these women and have started to evangelize them. Please pray for their salvation and for us as we minister to them, and for Alexander as he is organizing and traveling often to bring supplies and help to his people. We organized another humanitarian aid that he took to Ukraine and then worked on his farm for three weeks and safely returned early this week. His family was very glad to see him back, however he is planning to go back soon.

As far as our other ministries are concerned, we are doing well. There is a new couple attending our church and we are also planning a church retreat soon. We are looking forward to our camps and we have 30 children signed up so far. We are praising God for such a large number of people interested already. We are almost fully booked and have all our staff in place already. This year we will have a junior camp and one family camp. The preschools are doing well but we do have two teachers leaving us in the summer. Please pray as we need to hire new Polish teachers as well English teachers. Genesis preschool will also celebrate its 10th anniversary in October and we are excited to celebrate all that God has done.
