Opportunities

You have been praying for Wendy, a very kind lady that Debbie became acquainted with through a community choir in which they both participated. Wendy is slated for hip-replacement surgery, and when she realized that Debbie had been through it, a bond was formed between them. They have met numerous times, and Debbie has shared biblical truths with her. When Wendy became aware of Debbie's pancreatic cancer diagnosis in April, that relationship blossomed to include Wendy's husband, Ian. To thank him for several occasions of his help, I took him for coffee, and we got to know each other better. Pray for our relationship to develop further over the next several months. Especially pray that I would have the opportunity to talk about the Gospel with him.

I must first thank you for your faithful prayers over the past three months. "May the LORD fulfill all your petitions" (Psalm 20:5). On May 9 Debbie had surgery designed to remover her pancreas. However, this objective was not able to be fulfilled. After recovery from the surgery, Deb started a very aggressive form of chemotherapy July 1. A week after that first treatment Deb began to experience very serious side effects from the treatment and had to be admitted to hospital. She is home now, but treatment is being reassessed. You can stay updated on her treatment on a Facebook page entitled "Mama Talbert's Cancer Battle" managed by my daughters. Pray that Debbie might be supernaturally healed, that her treatment would be effective, and that God would be pleased to give her many more years to serve both her family and the many friends to whom she has ministered over our many years in Alberta.
