September 2022

Dear Praying Friends,

We're home! Our mini-furlough is complete, and we officially logged 13,200km on our van in 52 days. Two days before we were scheduled to leave, Darren needed a trip to the emergency department. Thankfully, the situation was soon resolved, and we were able to start our trip with only a few days' delay.

The drive was long, but it was wonderful to see so much of our beautiful country. We are thankful that the entire trip was completed without one flat tire, empty gas tank, or mechanical problem. Getting the bugs from seven different provinces off the van will be a different kind of adventure, however!

We were able to spend a few days in Edmonton to reconnect with family, most of whom we have not seen since before the onset of COVID measures.

It was a blessing to meet old friends and to make some new ones as well. We reported to five supporting churches and presented our church-planting ministry in three new churches. It was interesting to meet a few people who had some friends or acquaintances in the Surrey area. We are hoping to get their contact information so that we can follow up on these connections.

In our absence, Jim and Myra Wright did a great job in caring for New Life Baptist Church and looking after our home. There were a number of visitors to the church, and we are praying that we will be able to follow up and make connections with them now that we have returned.

We have much work to do in rebuilding the church, since the attendance has dwindled over the years. This fall will prove to be as busy as ever as we maintain a full schedule of services in the church and seek to meet and evangelize people in our community. In addition, Elizabeth will be continuing an almost full schedule of piano instruction. We are thankful to God for supplying the work for Elizabeth; without it, we would not be able to continue to live and minister in Surrey. Our daughter Charis will be (too) busy with two jobs and pursuing a master's degree in curriculum development.

Our next mini furlough to our U.S.-based churches is tentatively scheduled for 2024. In the past few weeks, some pastors expressed interest in visiting us in Surrey. We would love for any who are interested in doing so to connect with us. If you would like to bring a group of people out, we would love to host you.
