THE HUNTERS SOUTH AFRICA

September 2022

(excerpts from their latest prayer letter)

Dear Praying Friends,

We are so grateful to be able to announce that we (Herb, Janet and Noah) are all safely back in South Africa! - home again! In 2 Corinthians 5:9 Paul says that whether we are at home or away, we ought to be pleasing to the Lord. We have tried, by His grace, to be pleasing to Him, and He has been so good to us!

On July 25th Herb and Noah boarded a plane for South Africa, leaving Megan and Janet behind in Canada. Almost immediately after arriving there were pressing ministry needs and many, many attempts to reconnect with people who we had not seen for so long! It took a couple of days to recover from the effects of jet lag, but on Friday, July 29th, Herb and Noah participated in an Embark Youth activity. Herb spoke at our church plant on July 31 for the first time in several months – and what a happy reunion it was! George and Amy, helped by Jared and Shené did such a great job caring for the church in our absence. There are more people attending church now than there were when we left! We had secured premises to meet in, but alas, that was short-lived. We had to return the keys to the hall due to an ongoing legal dispute between the property owners and the property manager. It's a long and difficult story of all that transpired but for now, everyone is back to meeting in our living room. Please pray with us regarding a place for our church to meet. After the initial excitement of finding our own place, people are a bit discouraged with having to move back into the house.

Our counseling ministry is also back in full swing. Pray for those involved – and for Herb, that God would give wisdom in how to help those hurting people who come each week. Such stories of hurt from a broken world. Counselees tell stories of abandonment by family, childhood rape, and trauma. Still others struggle with anger and anxiety.

The flu is going around too. Noah has missed two weeks of school with bronchitis and Herb had to lay low for a couple of days with a persistent chest cough and sore throat. Please pray for our health. After being in North America for so long, we find ourselves susceptible to the South African strains of illness again.

Finally, on the 25th of August, Janet arrived back in Knysna. She has immediately jumped back into ministry, helping at Knysna Primary and teaching the Ladies Bible Study. Pray for the ministry initiatives she is involved in, that souls would come to faith in Christ and lives would be impacted for eternity.

So many of you helped us along the way while we were on our furlough, and we are grateful for you. We enjoyed our furlough, but it is great to be back home!
