MISSIONARY UPDATE



THE BURRILLS IN MALTA

(excerpts from their latest prayer letter)

October 2022

Dear Friends,

We were excited this summer to see some "firsts" in the church here. The third week of August we shifted our Sunday services to our new auditorium and we have all been enjoying that space as our attendance has increased to the numbers we had before the covid pandemic. Our newly renovated nursery area downstairs has been a blessing as we have had new families with young children attending. The first Sunday in September we held our first Sunday service in Gozo. Everyone was excited and we had many visitors in attendance. We have continued the Gozo Sunday service the first Sunday of each month, so have now had three Sunday services in addition to the weekly Wednesday meetings. Pray that our church (both in Malta and Gozo) will be knit together like family and that new people would be drawn into meaningful fellowship that reflects the unity and character of Christ.

Next week Erica will begin a ladies' Bible study on Tuesdays and the men will begin a Bible reading group using the messaging service, WhatsApp. Both means of getting people into the Word and discussing it together have proved to be beneficial and we are looking forward to this next round. Pray that our weekly Word ministry in all of its forms will bear fruit.

Thank you for praying for our family's health needs. Rowan had another flare-up of his nephrotic syndrome over the summer and is just finishing his course of medication. My health has been quite good. I take regular treatment for my Crohn's and my doctor conducted some extra diagnostic tests this summer as he isn't satisfied I am quite as healthy as I should be. I will see him in a couple weeks. We are grateful for the medical treatment we have here and for doctors who have been thorough in their care of us. Continue to pray for the Lord to sustain us for all He has for us to do.

We look forward to the arrival of Erica's parents in two weeks. They will stay in Malta for a couple months and we will really enjoy the time of family fellowship together. I will be making a trip to Istanbul the last week of October to coordinate another training week for Turkish church leaders. It will be good to see Pastor Antuan and Citidel and to further invest in the health and stability of church. Thank you to those who continue to support that ministry.

We have now been in Malta for five years and it is time for us to go through the process of health and financial checks with Baptist Mid-Missions. We plan to make a furlough trip during the summer next year.

Pray for our ministry team. We continue working together with the Tanis family here while the Mifsuds are back on a furlough. Pray for those who are growing in leadership in our church and progressively taking on new responsibilities. Pray that we would have the joy of seeing others saved during this next season of ministry.

Thank you for all you do to support the work of Christ's Great Commission in the Maltese islands. We are truly grateful for you.
