MISSIONARY UPDATE

There was a great turnout with Camp Genesis, which was held the first week of July. Fourteen Americans attended and helped out with the camp, teaching English lessons, making crafts, and helping wherever needed. Also, we were able to sponsor two children from Ukraine to attend our camp. The Bible lessons throughout the week focused on the Wordless Book. Each day the children had a Bible study. The point of Camp Genesis was to share the word of God, which was pretty well received. Nine kids were saved throughout the week and many seeds were planted among the other children. Praise the Lord!

The camp had almost the same staff from the previous year. There was one new staff member, Zuza, who used to be a camper at Camp Genesis. She became a leader this year and had her own group of children to guide and look after. During the camp, we talked to Zuza about Genesis Preschool, and as of this month, we have hired her as one of our new Polish teachers.

Both positions for new Polish teachers have been filled. Eva is the other new Polish teacher. She has never worked with kids before, besides her own children, but she is doing really well. She fits in nicely and is a great addition to the preschool. The school year already started, so you can be praying for the upcoming year, the children, and the staff.

Three new English teachers were hired: Hannah K., Hannah B., and Ashley D. Hannah K. and Ashley D. will be working at the preschool located in Jaworzno, and Hannah B. will be working at the preschool located in Leszczyny. Hannah B. will be staying with a family she knows, but they don't speak very much English. You can be praying for her and the family as they all transition during this time.

The three new English teachers are attending our church regularly. They attended our church picnic in August, where we were all able to fellowship and enjoy a big meal together. A family camp for our church was also held recently. It was very good for the families and fellowship with time away. Our study was about spiritual growth in homes.

Thank you for answers to our prayers. Last Saturday, we were contacted by a previous camper, named Daniel, who attended camp in 2011 and 2012. He called and wanted to let us know that he got saved. You can be praying for him as he is beginning his journey with the Lord.

The Ukrainian family went back to work on their farm. We expect them to come back after the harvest. They left some of their belongings here, so in case things get worse in Ukraine, they know they can come back here. The family's baby Maria was born on September 9th. You can be praying for the family as there is a lot of war activity in their town right now.

We are still involved in humanitarian help. There is a missionary through Campus Crusade for Christ who we donate items to, and he takes the items to the front lines in Ukraine. The items are delivered to military hospitals where they are greatly needed. The missionary- and all of us- truly appreciate all of the donations and prayers.
