MISSIONARY UPDATE

Dear Partners in the Gospel,

I recently read the phrase "partnership in the gospel" (Philippians 1:5 ESV) and stopped to reflect on its meaning in light of recent events. Since this letter is Paul's "thank you" for a new gift of monetary support, Paul is thinking of partnership in terms of finances. But it goes much deeper. Paul speaks of his affection for them as brethren, his prayers for them, his joy in them. All this I too think of when I write this letter to you. But I think of that partnership in one way Paul never did. That is, many of you wrote to me of your partnership in my grief for the loss of my wife, Debbie. Her partnership with me in the Gospel was incalculable. And so, your partnership with me in that loss is also incalculable. Thank you... for your partnership with me in my grief.

God's servants do their part, but when we have finished our part of the gospel race God will send others along to "take the baton" and begin their part. Please pray for God to send more laborers into His harvest – godly preachers, wives, children, and church leaders (Matthew 9:38). Pray that they would come out of Canadian churches, bound to labor both in Canadian churches and beyond. Pray that some of them would be led by God to be trained at Foundation Baptist College. And claim 1 John 5:14 as God's promise kept, "If we ask anything according to His will, He hears us."

I would like to praise God for several blessings. **1.** When Debbie was diagnosed with cancer, my oldest and youngest children, David and Emma, lived and worked out of the country. But by God's blessing they both moved back to Canada to help care for their mother (and father!). Their help added to the help of our children already living here has been enormous.

2. We praise God that David and his family—Desiree, and three children: Chloe (13), Paul (12), and James (6)—have settled in nicely to Canadian life. After fifteen years of service in Shanghai, China, they are here in Canada permanently. The children enjoy school, and Mom is seeking permanent status. David has a good job. Please pray for them as they seek to purchase a home of their own. Until they do, they are enjoying living in Grandpa's basement.

3. Emma received her RN in the US several years back, but Alberta did not license her to work as an RN. Several weeks ago, that changed very quickly. She is currently working as an ICU nurse at the University of Alberta Hospital! We praise God for opening this door so that Emma can also remain permanently in Alberta!

I am back at Lighthouse Baptist Church as interim senior pastor, but I did not teach at the college this semester. April 16 I was preaching all day at the church in Calgary which God allowed us to start (1988–2008). Pastor Michael Miller is doing a wonderful job shepherding the growing flock at Foundation Baptist Church. It was a great blessing to be back and see so many of the brethren there.

Please pray for a close friend who needs to get saved, the gospel preached at this year's graduation ceremony at the college (April 29), and for a much-needed visit to friends and family in South Carolina in May and June.
