Dear friends at Meadowlands Baptist Church,

Thank you so much for your kind donation to our Ukraine War Relief fund our people received in Ukraine through ABWE. In each message we receive from that beleaguered nation, our coworkers express heartfelt gratitude for all the different forms of aid they continue to receive, thanks to BIEM's supporters. In fact, some of them expressly point out how, without the War Relief, not only would their lives be harder, but it would be impossible for them to engage in the evangelistic outreaches they perform regularly.

They make an excellent point. Although none of us rejoices in the war, while it rages on, we see and seize amazing opportunities to reach souls for Christ. The hardships and deprivations of wartime have softened hearts and rearranged people's priorities. So many who never gave God a thought when they felt in control of their peaceful lives now listen to the Gospel with hope and appreciation.

The best news is not that your thoughtful donations provide food, clothing, and basic necessities to needy people (although these are valuable expressions of Christian compassion). The best news is that many Ukrainians have opened their hearts to the Word of God and embraced Christ. We thank God that our partnership with you is yielding a great harvest of souls. So much so that even though our churches in Ukraine have lost many members who fled the country, they have been replaced by new converts who continue to flow into our churches. In some cases, churches are fuller now than they were before the war!

We have directed your gift to a church that is conducting very impressive efforts to distribute war relief especially to widows and orphans of the many men who have been killed in the war, the Revival Baptist Church in the Obolon area of Kyiv. This is one of the first churches established by BIEM when Ukraine gained independence. It has been self-supporting for many years and has grown to be an amazing church in a strategic location of the Obolon area which has 400,000 residents. This church neighbors the court building, city administrative offices, the prosecutor's office, the fire department, the police department, a music conservatory and a teachers institute!! The city administration has turned to this church to help war victims in their area. There are so many that they need help in order to be able to do so. The Pastor of this church and the the President of the Brotherhood of Independent Baptist Churches of Ukraine express their thanks to the wonderful folks of Meadowlands Baptist Church.
