THE KOLTS POLAND

"Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners" 1 Timothy 1:15

Dear Friends,

Camp Genesis is one of our church ministries. This year camp lasted July 2nd through July 8th. The staff arrived a couple days earlier to go through training and set up for the camp. We felt that this facility was a perfect fit for us, with a field to play in, a separate, private building to meet in, and places nearby to walk to. The campers arrived on the night of July 2nd. There were around 20 staff members, including four leaders. Each leader had five or six kids.

From the very beginning, we shared the Gospel. We held leader and staff meetings, church services, and evening communities daily. The kids played sports, made crafts, and had English lessons. On the first full day, we hiked and took the kids to a village in the mountains where they did a ropes course and visited little shops in the area. A man from Open Doors joined us one evening and shared the Gospel. The leaders were very involved in their groups and had some deep conversations with each kid in their group. Several leaders and other staff members shared their testimonies with the children at the evening community service. The kids even had a chance to share their testimonies, and a couple of kids spoke of how they were just saved at our camp a few nights before. A few children stayed back after one evening community and prayed for their salvation. A total of 4 children made the decision to follow Jesus as their personal Savior.

This year at camp we provided practical training for people interested in running their own summer camps. Three couples came to our camp from northern and Eastern Poland to learn how to organize and run Christian Camps. We are glad that we could help to multiply camp ministry in Poland. Also, they were a blessing to us with help and encouragement.

You can pray for the children who were saved and their walk with Christ. You can also pray for the kids who have yet to be saved and for the seeds planted to one day be grown into their salvation with the Lord. Thank you for your prayer and financial support.

Here is a short testimony of our camper this year that I will remember for long time. (David 9 years old from Ukraine): "When I was 5 years old my mom started to take me to church. I asked my mom, 'Why are we going to church, since all I do there is play with my toys?' My mom answered, 'We are going to church to pray and listen to God's Word.' I asked my dad the same question. My dad answered, 'Son you don't have to go to church.' I asked my pastor, 'Why do we go to church?' My pastor answered: 'We are going to church so we can go to heaven.' After a few years go by, the war broke up and I moved to Poland. We went to church and again I started to ask people in church, 'Why do we go to church?' They answered, 'We go to church to know the truth.' Then I came to this camp and I found out here: That Jesus Christ came to this world to save me and give me eternal life!"
