October Update - Back in Malta

(excerpts from their latest prayer letter)

We arrived back in Malta in September to pick up life where we left off in June before our furlough. We have re-acclimated to the heat and humidity this time of year brings and feel like we are back in the routine of life and ministry.

Thank you to all who showed us great kindness during our time in North America. We are blessed to have you as friends and supporters. Thank you for your hospitality, gifts, time and concern. We will miss your in-person fellowship. Thank you to those who we were not able to visit, but who continue to faithfully support our work.

In our last update we presented a support need and we praise God for those needs being met for this coming year through current supporters. We will need to see longer term support built up as that extra support recedes next year, but we rejoice at God's good hand upon us and know that He cares for us in personal and specific ways.

The children began their school year one week ago, along with some extra curricular activities. Rowan is using a video homeschool program this year while the other three returned to the schools they attended last year. Rowan plans to return to Canada at the end of the school year so this may be our last year with all six of us together. One of Kian's school friends attended church with us, so pray that our children would not only have good friends this year, but make an impact in those friends' lives.

Our church experienced the sadness of losing our church treasurer to cancer the same day we left Canada. The memorial service was held after we returned and our teammate, Joe Mifsud, had the opportunity to preach gospel hope to many friends, relatives, and colleagues who attended. Pray that God's word would bear fruit from that occasion.

We have enjoyed reconnecting with our church people and meeting others who began attending while we were away in the summer. We are currently holding a new members class and anticipate 7-10 people joining the church later this month. The class has also provided an opportunity to see that some attenders do not yet understand the gospel. Pray for fruitful conversations and the salvation of those who attend our church, but have not yet trusted Christ for salvation. Our men's mentorship group met since we returned and I am encouraged to see their continuing heart for the Lord and a desire to keep learning, growing, and leading together. Erica will begin her ladies' Bible study next week and our teammate, Luke Tanis, is organizing new teen programs for this year. We continue ministry in Gozo and are trying to re-build our young adults group in the church as that demographic has changed in our church over the last couple years. Pray for our team we seek to represent the Lord well as His ambassadors and further strengthen and grow His church on the Maltese islands.

Many of you have been praying for my upcoming bowel surgery. It was originally scheduled for Monday, October 2nd, but I discovered that the date had been rescheduled to October 30th. I am glad for the extra time to work on ministry details before a recovery break in November. Thank you for praying for our health needs.

We appreciate all you are doing for us and pray you will have a fruitful Fall of ministry.
