MISSIONARY UPDATE



THE BURRILLS MALTA

(Excerpts from their recent prayer letter.)

For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus. -1 Timothy 2:5
What amazing grace that knowing the full extent of our sin, Christ still came and died for us! We continue to proclaim this message of good news here in Malta, and as we have been praying, in the last few weeks the Lord has shown us how He is already at work in people's lives before we even encounter them. While I was preaching last Sunday on Christ as our priest who sacrificed himself, a young Nigerian student who had identified himself as Roman Catholic last week kept nodding his head and thanked me afterward for the good teaching. Pray for him and others who have heard the gospel over the past few weeks to trust in Christ for salvation.

We continue our regularly scheduled services in Malta and Gozo with special events and young adult and teen meetings taking place. This month we enjoyed some extra fellowship with a men's breakfast, ladies fellowship, our annual church banquet and children's program. We thank God for all who attended. The ministry on the university campus has been small in number, but there have been significant conversations and even unexpected connections the Lord has arranged through that ministry. Pray for our new believers as they face various battles and learn how to turn to the Lord instead of the old ways. Pray for a few who will be baptized on the first Sunday of 2024. We thank the Lord for seven new members who joined the church in November. Pray that the Lord will further stabilize and grow the church to one day be self-supporting and supporting of new gospel initiatives across the islands and the greater region. It is a joy to serve alongside our BMM colleagues and others in our church whose hearts are wholeheartedly in the ministry.

Thank you for praying for my health and recent bowel surgery. The operation was successful and after nine days in hospital and seven weeks of recovery, I am feeling mostly back to normal. I still do not have my full energy back, but for the last couple weeks I have been back to a normal schedule. As I am changing a medication and getting built back up, continue to pray for my health. Rowan's health has been stable this year, so we are grateful for that. After an autumn of busily getting back into the ministry following a summer furlough and then going through the recovery process of the last while, we are looking forward to a slow week of family time during the Christmas break.

We are so thankful for your prayer and financial support of the ministry and for the many Christmas gifts that we have received. May we be set for steady, unmovable, abounding service for our Lord in 2024. In Christ,
