MISSIONARY UPDATE

April 2024

Dear Friends.

First of all, I would like to apologize for the long break in writing updates. It was quite a difficult time for us, but also a fruitful one. Our church building has already undergone 3 auction sales, but it has still not been sold. One of our elders started a 4 year program in the Bible School. Pawel is a coal miner and been with us right from the beginning of our church plant in 2014. He's come a long way. He got really involved in the church, diligently studying the Word of God and showing love for the people. I

believe God is using Pawel to be one of the future Shepherds in our fellowship.

As a result of my teaching in the Bible Institute, we got a new member in our church. His name is Janusz and he is a truck driver and a new believer. We will have a baptismal service on 14 of April for Janusz and Dorota, (Pawel's wife). Please pray for them that they will grow in the Lord for His glory. Also, please pray that our church will have a place to meet. Our Church Fellowship for us personally is a huge blessing. We love spending time with our church family in good times and challenging times. This last few months was challenging for both of our preschools. As a result, my wife and I assumed a lot of extra responsibilities. In addition, we discovered that the county office was cheating on student subsidy. This is a legal challenge with local government that may take months to resolve and could be enormously expensive and time consuming. Please pray for quick, fair judgment and the future of the school.

My mother will be 88 years old in August. She was saved and baptized in 2018. Till recent months she was living on her own. However, she fell in her apartment and spent a few months in the hospital. She was diagnosed with dementia and is slowly gaining her mobility. However, she is not able to live on her own and has to be under medical care.

The Genesis summer camp this year will take place in the rocky mountains at the town of Zakopane from June 28 till July 06. We were able to recruit all the staff needed for this camp and we will have 7 people coming to help from our home church in Canada and 4 people from USA. We are sponsoring Polish and Ukrainian children to attend the camp. Thank You for sponsoring so far 4 children for camp this year. If the Lord is leading you to sponsor a child as well, the camp fee is \$250 US. Please

pray about the growth of our church, the staff for the pre-school, the attendance at the preschools, the school and church

buildings, the support of Ukraine and our summer camps.
