We maintain a friendship with her and would love to see her come to faith in

The counseling ministry also continues. Janet has engaged with a teen girl who has been sexually molested by a boy in her community. Janet has gently come alongside her to share the Word and to help this young girl see her need of Christ as well as helping her heal from the trauma of abuse in her past. Herb and Janet have spent some time with a pre-teen boy and then with his parents in the hopes of sorting out what is going on in the home.
