Dear Friends,

September 2024

I'm excited to share the latest updates on our mission in Poland. We have positive accomplishments in all of our areas of operations: Summer camps, church plant and our schools.

Our July Summer camp was held in the mountains of Zakopane. This year we were blessed with visitors from our home church in Canada that included seven members with senior and assistant pastors. Also, camp was attended by our friends from Wisconsin, Illinois and Ohio. In addition, we had 11 Polish staff members that gave us a record staff of 22 members. Like every year, we started with leaders training where we made plans and preparations before campers arrived at the camp. All of the staff left their heart at the camp serving in a different way, training, teaching, giving their testimony, teaching English, doing crafts, helping with sports, playing games and making connections with the campers that never been exposed to Christianity or came from difficult backgrounds. We were able to sponsor several of them that came from foster care or Ukrainian communities affected by war. It was a great privilege to see some of them give their life to Christ at the end of the week. We are very thankful to all staff members for a great week of camp this year.

It is hard to believe that we already started our 13th school year this month at our initial Genesis Preschool. We still have a shortage of Polish teachers and are starting a school year with no English teachers. However, we were able to recruit two new English teachers out of USA, thanks to the help of "Teach Them Diligently". As of September first, our second preschool that we started and developed in 2018 was turned over to a local church. That was the plan right from the beginning and we are glad that this finally happened. We will still help and advise this preschool until it is fully self-sufficient.

Our new church member Janusz was baptized along with Pawel's wife Dorota.

Pawel finished his first year of Bible School and is looking forward to his second year that will start later this month. Pawel is a great help to our church plant and myself personally. Pawel delivered a few sermons over the Summer and church members noticed a great improvement since he is attending a Bible School. Janusz, since he was baptized, fervently witnesses to all his family members. He constantly asks for prayers for many of them by name. So far, he was able to lead to Christ his mother and his sister. Now we are praying for his wife and two daughters to get saved.

We covet your prayers in all of these areas of operations, we are very thankful for your partnership with us.
